Re-thinking Faith in the 21st Century

The program is called “Seminary of the 3rd Age”, and will be offered on Thursday evenings from 7 to 8.30pm, in four 4 week modules during the months of March, May, August and October. It will cover topics of The God Factor, The Interpretation Factor, The Jesus Factor and The Soul Factor, with sessions led by eleven well known thinkers, such as Andrew Dutney, Vicky Balabanski and Sean Gilbert.
