Re-thinking Faith in the 21st Century

As our main Conversations activity for this year, we are inviting all, who would enjoy discussing the place of faith in our lives, to join the program being offered by the Progressive Christianity Network SA at the Effective Living Centre, 26 King William Road, Wayville.

The program is called "Seminary of the 3rd Age", and will be offered on Thursday evenings from 7 to 8.30pm, in four 4 week modules during the months of March, May, August and October. It will cover topics of The God Factor, The Interpretation Factor, The Jesus Factor and The Soul Factor, with sessions led by eleven well known thinkers, such as Andrew Dutney, Vicky Balabanski and Sean Gilbert.

To introduce the program, a launch event will be held on Thursday, 22nd February – same times and venue. This is a free event, hosted by Lynn Arnold, with wine and cheese to follow. We encourage you to go along to get "a taste of the year's menu".
